



Radon ORDER FORM

Radon is a naturally occurring, odorless, tasteless, radioactive gas produced by the breakdown of uranium in rocks and soil. It is harmlessly dispersed in outdoor air, but when trapped in buildings, it can be harmful, especially at elevated levels. Radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer after smoking. Because radon is a problem that is not well publicized, but does threaten the public, the Utah Safety Council has instituted its Radon Awareness Program. Educational materials and low cost radon test kits are available from the Utah Safety Council.
