Deck the Halls With Fire Safety

It's time to deck the halls! But, did you know that in 2012, 136,314 children under 19 were injured as a result of a fire or burn? Did you also know that the top three days for fires caused by home candles are Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day?


Holiday decorations such as lights and candles may be a great sight to see, but they can quickly become a sore spot to your family festivities without the proper safety precautions.

Safely set the stage for your family's holiday merriment by practicing these safety tips.

- Drink it in. If you have a real Christmas tree this year, they will need plenty of water or they could become a fire hazard. Remember, a hydrated tree is a safer tree!
- Too Close For Comfort. Do not place a tree within 3 feet of a space heater, fireplace, or heat vent. The tree should also not block any windows or doors in the house.
- Tame the Flame. Keep candles at least 12 inches away from your tree and any other decorations.
- Lights Out. Turn off the tree, decorative lights, and blow out any candles when you go to bed or leave the house.
- Merry and Bright. Check all lights for fraying, aging, or heat damage. Do not overload any electrical outlets and double check for any broken sockets or loose connections.




