
Occupational Health and Safety in the 1970s

The 1970s were a significant time for improvements in Occupational Health and Safety. President Richard Nixon signed into law the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (known as OSHA) on December 29, 1970 under the OSH Act. OSHA then became effective on April 28, 1971.

OSHA's goal is to assure safe and healthful working conditions for everyone. OSHA accomplishes this goal through enforcing standards and providing training, outreach, education, and assistance. Since the establishment of OSHA, workplace incidents, illnesses, and injuries have dramatically decreased.




