Occupational Safety Training

Each year, the Utah Safety Council offers approximately 150 courses covering various topics in occupational safety. These include Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Compliance Courses for General Industry and Construction, Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) New Miner and Refresher Training, and Contractor Safety Orientation (UITC) courses. Occupational courses range from half-day presentations to programs that are four days in duration. These courses are designed for all levels of safety expertise. Subjects include generic preparatory courses such as Principles of Occupational Safety and Health, Fundamentals of Industrial Hygiene, Lift Truck Instructor Certification, as well as courses that focus on specific subject areas such as Machine Safeguarding. Over 400 people attended our professional development courses at the Utah Safety Council during 2013. Over 75 special occupational courses were also held for organizations throughout Utah.

Contractor Safety Orientation (UITC)

The Contractor Safety Orientation course is designed for contractors or contractor employees who perform work on refinery properties. This one-day program is administered by the Utah Safety Council for the association of local petrochemical companies (Utah Industrial Training Cooperative). Topics include: general industrial safety, hearing conservation, elevated work, electrical safety, hand safety and the worker's role in safety. Over 2,800 people received this certification during 2013.

Mine Safety & Health Training (MSHA)

The Utah Safety Council has a MSHA approved training program. During 2013, courses were twice a month to help certify and re-certify those working in a surface metal/non-metal mining location, as well as underground locations. Training includes new/inexperienced miner training and annual training for experienced miners. Over 1,600 people received their MSHA certification from the Utah Safety Council during 2013.



Advanced Safety Certificate

The Utah Safety Council offers the National Safety Council's *Advanced Safety Certificate* (ASC) program. This certificate program is designed to maximize effectiveness for safety leaders and help establish best safety practices for an organization. ASC courses are field tested and offer practical and efficient solutions to workplace safety and health issues. Students are taught techniques to address administrative, technical and cultural elements that affect safety within their organizations. Upon fulfilling the requirements of the program, students have the ability to assess the safety needs in their workplace and implement the appropriate countermeasures to eliminate unsafe conditions and reduce the frequency of unsafe acts.

Certificate in OSHA Compliance

The Utah Safety Council also offers the National Safety Council's Certificate in OSHA Compliance courses. These courses give students the ability to read and interpret specific OSHA standards in order to comply, avoid fines, and make their workplaces safer for all. Participants choose the compliance issues that are most important to their organization and receive in-depth reviews of the relevant standards through these courses.

Scholarship Program

During 2013, the Utah Labor Commission awarded a \$32,000 grant to the Utah Safety Council that provided scholarships to selected training offerings. Scholarships consist of partial tuition subsidies for Utah businesses. A total of 174 scholarships were awarded to 125 companies. Since the inception of the program, approximately 2,200 scholarships have been awarded.



First Aid, CPR and AED Training

The Utah Safety Council offers the National Safety Council's first aid training programs. These programs and accompanying certifications are nationally recognized. Employees trained in CPR and first aid have the power to save lives. Learning to respond effectively will also protect them at home, where an emergency can cost the same in lost work time and productivity. How employees react before emergency medical services arrive could make the difference between life and death.

These courses provide participants with the most up-to-date First Aid, CPR and AED training specifically focused on medical emergencies in the workplace. Participants learn life-saving skills including treatment for shock, bleeding and wounds, burns, medical emergencies and more.

Over 700 people completed the first aid, CPR and AED course during 2013. Additionally, 53 on-site first aid courses were held at various companies throughout Utah during 2013.

First Aid, CPR and AED Instructor Certification

The Utah Safety Council's emergency care instructor training meets OSHA guidelines for First Aid and CPR in the workplace and the latest CPR and Emergency Cardiovascular Care Guidelines. Participants are taught methods that involve, influence and facilitate adult learning while refining their teaching skills. This course covers a proven, standardized method of teaching First Aid and CPR with high effectiveness. A total of 34 people received their instructor credentials during 2013.

Automated External Defibrillators

The Utah Safety Council is a distributor of Philips Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs). Two AED Lunch & Learns were sponsored by the Utah Safety Council during 2013, on March 27 and September 4th. Many individuals were able to attend these hands-on events and learn firsthand how easy it is to use an AED.

In 2013, 54 AED units were sold to 28 different organizations. The Utah Safety Council trained all of these organizations on how to properly use their new AEDs.



Defensive Driving

The Utah Safety Council conducts *Defensive Driving Courses* in 11 locations throughout Utah.

Over 4,300 individuals completed the *Defensive Driving* public courses in 2013. This four-hour course covers an array of topics from hazardous road conditions to safe following distances. Upon completion of the course, attendees are eligible to receive a 50 point reduction from their Utah driving record. Students who are 55 years of age or older, may receive discounts on their automobile insurance premiums.

Many employers have also taken advantage of the *Defensive Driving Course* by either arranging an on-site course, or by training their own instructor to offer the course to their employees. During 2013, 14 on-site courses were conducted which trained 237 participants.

Instructor Development Courses are taught twice each year for those interested in becoming certified to teach Defensive Driving. Twenty-six individuals completed the Instructor Development course during 2013.

Online Defensive Driving

The Utah Safety Council offers the National Safety Council's *Online Defensive Driving Course* (DDC). This course is a self-paced driver improvement program. In approximately four-hours, DDC Online offers practical strategies to reduce collision-related injuries, fatalities and costs. The course is utilized by Utah companies to train their employees. The course is available in English and Spanish. During 2013, over 1,500 individuals completed the online course. Approximately 63 courts utilize the Utah Safety Council's Online *Defensive Driving Course*.

Alive at 25

Alive at 25 is a young driver intervention program developed by the National Safety Council for drivers between 15 and 24 years of age. It is a four-hour program that focuses on the decision making processes and behaviors that young drivers and passengers display in a motor vehicle. All courses are taught by law enforcement officers and are currently offered in various high schools and courts throughout Utah. The *Alive at 25* course also qualifies for a 50 point reduction on a Utah Driver License.



Alive at 25: Continued

Approximately 1,500 students completed the *Alive at 25* course in 2013. Seven schools support the *Alive at 25* program by regularly holding courses at their location. In addition, several courts refer young traffic offenders to the *Alive at 25* course. Since *Alive at 25* was implemented in Utah in October 2007, over 8,000 students have taken this course.

NETS

The *Utah Network of Employers for Traffic Safety* (NETS) is administered by the Utah Safety Council. The goal of the program is to help Utah businesses reduce the costs associated with motor vehicle crashes through implementation of effective on-the-job traffic safety programs.

Supported by over 1,000 local employers, the *Utah Network of Employers for Traffic Safety* is continually striving to reduce the number of traffic crashes involving Utah workers and their families by helping employers design and implement traffic safety programs.

Tow Truck Driver Certification

Since its launch in January 2011, over 650 Utah tow truck drivers have received their tow truck driver certification through the Utah Safety Council's online program. This is the first tow truck driver certification program in Utah that is entirely online for the convenience of tow truck drivers. This course has been approved by the Motor Carrier Division of the Utah Department of Transportation as meeting the requirements of an authorized program through which to obtain designation as a Certified Tow Truck Driver. This certification covers topics specific to Utah's laws and driving conditions.



Take Safety Home

The Utah Safety Council also delivers programs and educational services directed at keeping individuals safe in their homes and communities. The number of deaths from injuries in the home now rivals the number of deaths from motor vehicle crashes. The *Take Safety Home* program provides resources and materials to assist employers in implementing a Home Safety Program in their workplace. *Take Safety Home* focuses on the top five causes of home related unintentional injuries and deaths: poisonings, falls, drowning, choking and fires/burns. Educational materials, including an interactive Home Safety CD and several brochures, are available free of charge. During 2013, the Utah Safety Council participated in 27 community and business safety fairs. The *Take Safety Home* materials were distributed at these events.

Buckle Up For Love

The *Buckle Up For Love* program was implemented by the Utah Safety Council in 1995. The program is designed to reduce the number of injuries and fatalities that occur due to children riding unrestrained in a motor vehicle. Those who observe a child that is not restrained in a child safety seat or safety belt are encouraged to call 800.887.KIDS with the license plate number, location of the automobile, approximate age of the child and the date and time of the observation. The Utah Safety Council ensures that the owner of the observed vehicle receives life-saving information regarding the use and importance of child safety seats. Observations can also be reported by filling out an online form or by mailing observation cards. *Buckle Up For Love* materials are available free of charge from the Utah Safety Council. In 2013 approximately 140 people were sent educational packets about child passenger safety and over 39,000 print materials about the program were distributed to the community. In addition, 27 car seats were checked during 2013.

In the Community

The Utah Safety Council has continually focused its efforts on promoting health and protecting life, and in that regard, it has been consistently and actively involved in programs that benefit the greater community. Over the years, the Utah Safety Council has been an active participant with the Utah Safe Kids Coalition, the Coalition for Utah Traffic Safety and the Utah Teen Driver Taskforce.




Safety Media Library

The Utah Safety Council's *Safety Media Library* is one of the largest, most comprehensive safety libraries with over 900 up-to-date titles. Titles contained in the library cover a broad spectrum of subjects including traffic safety, home safety, occupational safety and various other general safety topics. A complete listing of the presentation titles, production dates and length of programs can be found online at www.utahsafetecouncil.org. Member feedback is taken into consideration when purchasing new materials for the library.

The Utah Labor Commission's Workplace Safety Grant Program provided \$20,000 during 2013 to help the Utah Safety Council provide the latest and most helpful training media presentations. During 2013, 90 new safety DVDs were added to the library. In addition, safety titles were loaned over 4,000 times and viewed by more than 44,000 people.

Utah Safety Council Website

The Utah Safety Council's website provides the latest tools and information to its members, customers and the community. The website is continually updated to provide the most current safety training, resources and information. The number of visitors to the Utah Safety Council's website continues to increase. During 2013, the site averaged over 7,500 visitors per month.
