Does Your Electrical Safety Program Need a Refresh?

In the electrical industry, there is little room for error. A commitment to safety protocols can mean the difference between life and death, especially when working with equipment carrying voltage, current or potentially exposed wires.

To allow for continuous improvement, it is advised electrical professionals closely follow the most recent guidelines set forth by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) article 70E: Standards for Electrical Safety in the Workplace. The NFPA has just released an updated version of its electrical safety standards.

NFPA 70E is a "how to comply" standard for OSHA 1910 Subpart S and OSHA 1926 Subpart K.

A few changes that were implemented in the 2018 NFPA 70E manual:

- **Electrical Safety** Added focus to identifying hazards and reducing the risk
- Changes in Planning for Job Safety including completion by a qualified person, documentation and more.
- Changes in Risk Assessments Added emphasis on the estimate of likelihood and severity
- Changes to Personal Protective Equipment addresses conformity assessment and marking requirements

It is crucial for employees to understand and closely follow the guidelines set forth by NFPA 70E. The Utah Safety Council has a 4-hour training on NFPA 70E: Electrical Safety to assist your company in increasing its Electrical Safety Culture. We have instructors available to come to your location and train your team.

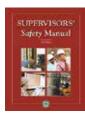

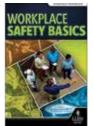

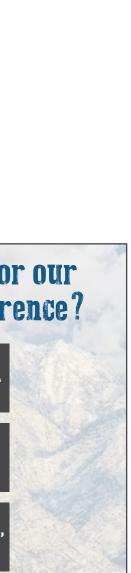
