Poison Prevention is Everyone's Responsibility



Poisonings are more common and deadly than you realize. Drug related poisonings cause nearly 700,000 visits to hospital emergency rooms and 48,000 deaths each year (National Safety Council, 2017). Young people are the most likely to be poisoned, with children under age six accounting for half of all poison exposures, while 9 out of 10 poisoning deaths occur among people over the age of 20. This means it's important to address poison prevention in people of all ages. National Poison Prevention Week is March 18-24th, what better time to educate yourself on poison prevention?

Keep the Poison Control number (1-800-222-1222) in your phone and in an easy to spot area in your home. Never hesitate to call Poison Control.

To prevent poisoning, follow these helpful Do's and Don't's:

Do:

- Store medicines and household products out of sight and reach of children.
- Store all household products and medicines separately and away from food.
- Store all cleaning products or potential poisons in their original containers and never store them in containers used for other reasons.

Don't:

- Keep expired or unneeded medications. Periodically clean out medicine cabinets and safely dispose of medications.
- Refer to medicine as candy. Always call it by its real name.
- Assume that an herbal medicine is safe because it's natural. Always consult with a physician.
