Stayin' Alive - Quick Tips for Effective CPR

It's a beautiful summer day. The sun is out, the temperature is perfect, and you're taking a leisurely walk. Suddenly, your perfect day takes a 180° turn, and the person walking in front of you collapses. Will you ask yourself, "Now what?"

Are you going to freeze? Or are you going to act? Can you stay calm? And while you're thinking through all this, how much precious time are you using before you provide the victim with the help they desperately need?

According to the National Safety Council, the current survival rate for sudden cardiac arrest is less than 7%. You can dramatically improve those odds with training that prepares you to respond to choking, breathing and cardiac emergencies.



Here are some quick tips on how to provide efficient CPR:

- 1. Think of the Bee Gee's song, "Stayin' Alive." It has the perfect rhythm and beat for preforming CPR. Hum along to it while performing CPR, and you're halfway there.
- 2. Make sure when you're pressing on the chest you let it go down, and ALL the way back up for full recoil.
- 3. Perform 30 chest compressions for every two breaths.


