Big West Oil has been a member of the Utah Safety Council since 1986. We appreciate their continued support and dedication to safety.




Just Keep Swimming

Summer is just weeks away and we know kids will be racing to hit the pool as soon as they can. However fun pool days are, we should never forget that it only takes mere seconds for a sunny day to go south.

For National Water Safety Month, we want to encourage you to take extra precautions by practicing the five survival skills below with all your family members!

Swim Survival Skills

- 1. Step or jump into water over your head and return to the surface.
- 2. Float or tread water for one minute.
- 3. Turn around in a full circle and find an exit from the water.
- 4. Swim 25 yards to the exit.
- 5. Exit from the water. If in a pool, be able to exit without using the ladder.

"OSHA General Industry or Construction Industry- what's the difference?" This question has been asked many times, and it's a good one.


Both the OSHA 10 General and Construction will cover electrical safety, fall protection, personal protective equipment, and the general function of OSHA. The two courses begin to differ with industry-specific topics. A construction course usually covers excavation safety, hand/power tool safety, 'struck by' hazards, and several other topics, while the general industry will usually cover ergonomics, exit routes, fire prevention, and hazard communication.


