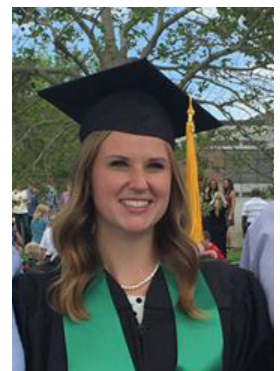

- Never allow young children to handle fireworks.
- Do not allow any running or horseplay while fireworks are being used.
- Always store fireworks in a dry, cool place.
