A PARENTS' CHECKLIST: FIRE SAFETY

- Are matches and cigarette lighters stored out of children's sight and reach?
- Have your children been taught to tell an adult if they find matches or lighters?
- Have you identified and eliminated fire and burn hazards in your home?
- Do you know basic first aid for burns?
- Is there a working smoke alarm on each floor of your home?
- Do you have (and know how to use) a fire extinguisher?
- Do you have a family escape plan? Does your family practice it?
- Have you taught your children how to report an emergency?
- Do your children know how to stop, drop and roll if their clothes catch on fire?
- Do you always stay in the kitchen when food is cooking on the stove?
- Do you know and follow basic guidelines for outdoor fire safety (cooking fires, campfires, wild land fire safety, fireworks, fuel safety and electrical safety)?
- Is gasoline stored in a UL-approved container and kept out of the house in a garage or shed?
