REGISTER YOUR CHILD RESTRAINT

Oftentimes, child safety seats are recalled by the manufacturer for various reasons. Some of these recalls are related to the crash worthiness of the restraint; therefore, it is critical that these seats be registered in order for the consumer to be notified of the recall and receive further instruction from the manufacturer.

Since 1993, all child safety seats are supplied with registration cards, but if yours has been lost or thrown away, you can register your seat on the manufacturer's website. To register, you will need the following information:

- Your name
- Your current mailing address
- Car seat manufacturer's name
- Date of manufacture
- Model number
- Model name

The manufacturer information can be found on a label attached to the seat, similar to the picture below.
